FURY SET FOR BLAZE & BCB IN SEASON OPENING GAMES

Signs Express Fury Basketball club get the 26 -27 basketball season underway this week-end with a series of top flight games against their key Scottish rival Boroughmuir Blaze and in the BCB British Trophy, the Senior Men hit the road to Halifax, where they open their group games against Yorkshire Dragons. The Friday and Saturday will see 6 games against Blaze starting off on Friday at 7.50pm at Grangemouth Sports Centre, when League, Cup and Play-Off Winners Fury Men play Blaze. The Men's team then travel to Halifax on Sunday to face a Dragon's side who defeated them in the Trophy semi-final last season.

Fury Headcoach John Bunyan sees all his players return for the Scottish and BCB Campaigns with the addition of exciting forward Matt Naylor and in the BCB games former Rocks player Fergus Harte.

Key for Fury will be their guard line up of former Rocks/Gladiators pair- Jonny Bunyan and Bantu Burroughs, Lithuanian Eddie Leginas and Fergus Harte a key addition with talented junior Humza Fadel now at Oakland Wolves in England.

Former pro Gladiator, American Prince Onwas will be a huge key for Fury in their BCB and Scottish season games being a multi position player.

Fury, are not short in power in their inside game with former pro players Ali Fraser and Murray Hendry big scorers who are also a threat from the perimeter. Ziggy Dauksas and Adnan Jalil are key forwards with the exciting Jack Hencher, fully fit and adding to Fury's firepower. American Javon Daniels and Yves J Ndongala will also be key off the bench.

The Men's BCB game on Sunday will see them having played 2 games in 3 days and with a long road trip the challenge against a very talented Dragons side will certainly be tough. Fury will fly the flag for Scottish basketball in the BCB with Blaze not taking part this season. The BCB Trophy sees 20 clubs across the UK take part - 18 top English sides, one Welsh and Fury. Fury's group games will see them at home on the 12th and 26th September - 2pm tips against Newcastle and Nottingham with a 4th game on the road at Derby on the 19th.

Entry to Fury's game against Blaze at GSC is 7.30pm this Friday and tickets will be on sale for both Fury's BCB home games on the club's Facebook and media outlets.

Fury will have 16 teams competing throughout the season and are once again one of only a few clubs in Scotland competing in all 8 of Scotland's top Division 1 Leagues.

These are Senior Men and Woman, U18 Junior Men and Woman, U16 Cadet(te) Men and Woman and U14 Boys and Girls.

The Falkirk sides will compete across the length and breadth of Scotland. The club will also have second teams playing in the Lothian League Division 1

at Senior Men and Woman, U18 Men and U14 Boys. The club's U12 Boys and Girls and U10 squads will also be in National competition throughout the season. Completing the club's squads are the Woman's Pick-up group who will play friendlies.

This Saturday sees a number of big games with Fury and Blaze key contenders for Scottish Division 1 League titles with the U18 Junior Men's clash at GSC at 2.20pm the standout game. Both sides are stacked with International players and two of the most experienced coaches in the country with Keith Buryan for Fury and Alan Keane for Blaze calling the plays. Prior to the JM game, Fury Cadet Men also face Blaze and this will also showcase some key developing talent in Scottish basketball.

On the road at the Craggs SC in Edinburgh on Saturday, Fury travel to Blaze's home venue when the U16 Woman face off at 12.20pm with the Junior Woman at 2.20pm and the Senior Woman at 4.20pm. Both clubs have strong teams in all 3 age groups and there promises to be exciting match ups in all 3 games. 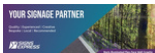
